

Foreword

The goal of integrated justice initiatives such as British Columbia's Justice Information System (JUSTIN) is to leverage advances in information technology to improve public safety and increase the efficiency of the justice system. Appropriate sharing of electronic information among the Judiciary, criminal justice agencies and law enforcement agencies can maximize these benefits.

Increasing interest in electronic access to the information in JUSTIN, combined with the ongoing development of other integrated justice systems, has highlighted the need for a consistent approach to managing electronic access to JUSTIN. In response to this need, the JUSTIN Electronic Access Policy and Procedures have been developed.

Implementation of the JUSTIN Electronic Access Policy and Procedures will enable the government of British Columbia to bring consistency and coherence to the decision-making and procedures associated with managing requests for electronic access to JUSTIN. It will ensure that appropriate access will be permitted, thereby maximizing the benefits offered by JUSTIN.
